ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

1st Leaf Produce Ltd has been established for 3 years and supplies a range of seedling salads, microgreens and baby herbs to premier restaurants and hotels throughout Pembrokeshire, which for maximum quality and freshness, are delivered living and then harvested fresh by the chef.

The Company will comply with all relevant environmental legislation and has a commitment to preventing pollution of the environment.

The Company's environmental impacts are:

Energy

Electricity is used for maintaining temperatures and supplementary lighting in the growing of produce. Gas is used for heating greenhouses.

Water

Water is used throughout the process of growing.

Waste

Growing medium as part of the process. Plastic, cardboard and office consumables.

Transport

Delivery of produce by vehicle.

The Company recognises these impacts and will strive to make continual improvements by:

- Minimising the amount of energy used through the prudent use of resources and through the implementation of energy saving devices such as thermostats and time clocks;
- Reducing the use of water consumption used for site processes by considering on-site water recycling options wherever possible;
- Minimising, recovering and recycling waste wherever possible specifically using returnable containers for delivery and re-composting waste compost;
- Carefully planning delivery routes and purchasing vehicles based on fuel economy.

The Policy will be subject to annual review starting in 2007 and will be regularly discussed within the company and made available to all interested parties.
